FY25’s GHG inventory reflects an expanded organizational boundary compared to prior years, enabled by improved data visibility, quality and stakeholder engagement.

Scope 3 Emissions

In 2025, we resumed our Scope 3 footprint calculations to prepare for upcoming regulations and to further strengthen the rigor and transparency of our environmental data. In addition, we conducted a thorough site-level review of utilities-consumption data to better understand our monthly usage variance, seasonal fluctuations, and potential metering and billing errors. A cross-functional facilities team, with the support of a data management provider, developed a data monitoring system and quarterly review process. We anticipate that these changes will further improve the accuracy of environmental footprinting data and support our assurance preparedness.
