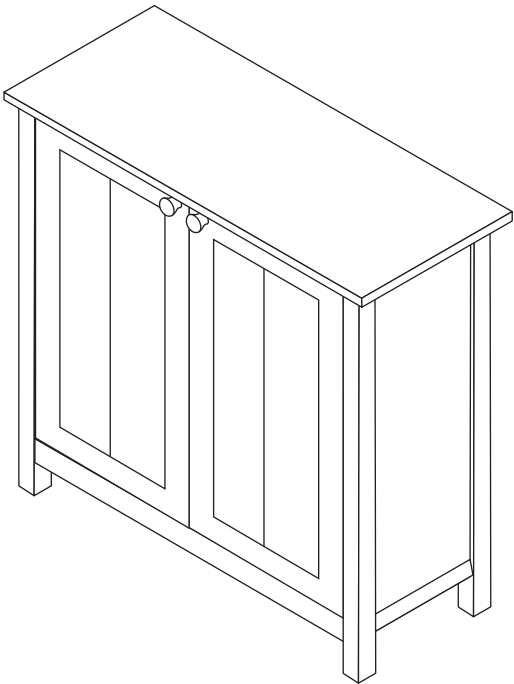


29-GALLON WOOD TANK STAND

Congratulations! You now have a beautiful piece of furniture to showcase your aquarium or terrarium.



CARE OF WOOD

Subtle variations in color and grain patterns inherent to each of the materials may occur. These natural characteristics enhance the unique beauty of each material. Avoid any extreme humidity or temperature, which can accelerate cracking of finish. This can also loosen joints and veneer. Avoid direct sunlight as much as possible. UV light will cause discoloration of the wood. Set anything wet or prone to condensation (beverage glasses) on surfaces with a coaster or mat for protection. Dust often with a soft cloth. Occasionally use a slightly dampened (with solvent-based cleanser) cloth to wipe the surface. This will help pick up more dust. When finished, immediately wipe with a dry cloth or soft paper towel. Do not use abrasives. To help prevent scratching of table top surfaces, a furniture paste can be applied following manufacturer directions. FOR DARK WOOD FINISHES: The surface of these finishes can be easily scratched, therefore, we do NOT recommend any furniture polishes or waxes. Wipe the surface down with a mild surface/counter cleaner using a soft cloth. Take extra care to protect these surfaces with placemats and runners in order to prevent light scuffing from daily use.

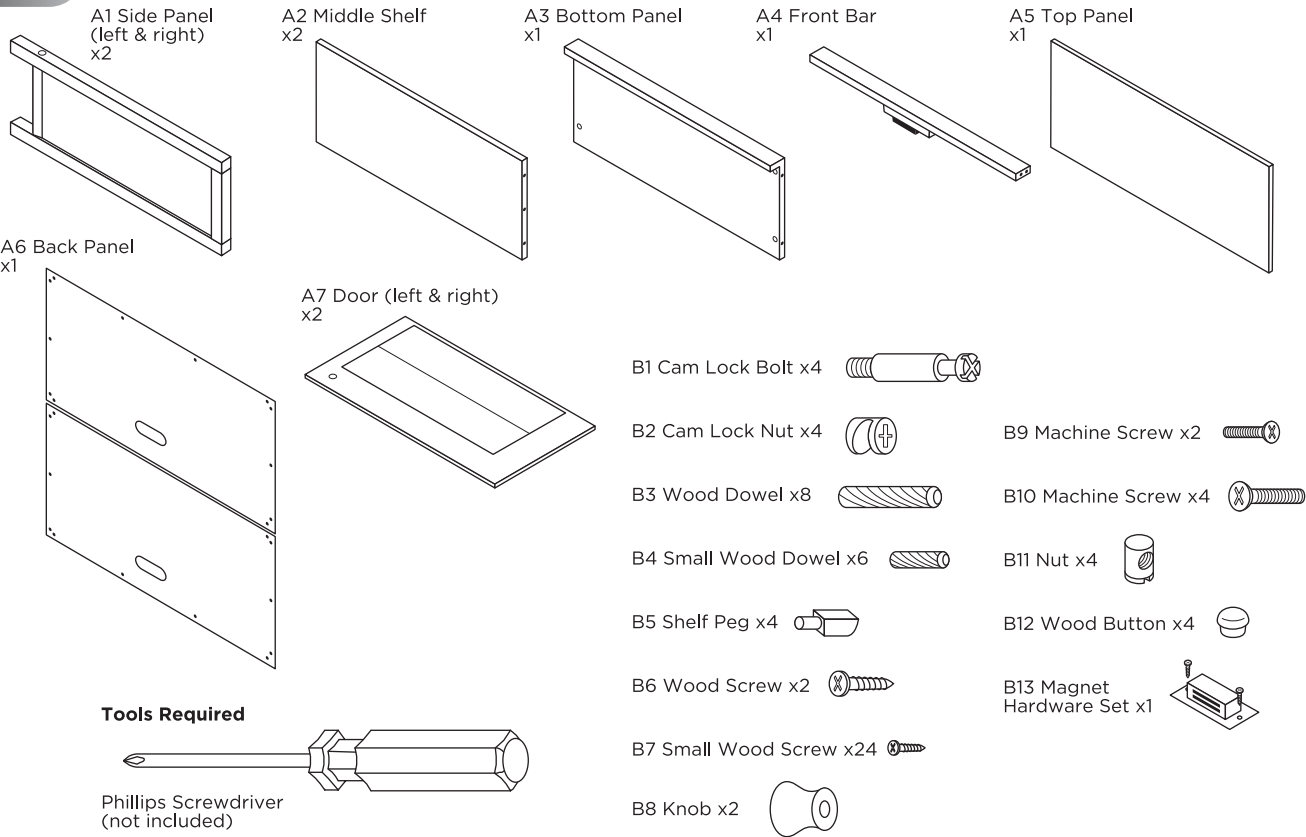
CAUTION: NOT SUITABLE FOR CHILDREN.

Follow assembly instructions closely. To avoid damage to aquarium, bottom surface of tank should be flat and level when placed on stand. Wipe off excess water to preserve the finish of the stand. Inspect regularly and replace if any part becomes damaged. Place stand on level and stable ground. For additional stability, we recommend placing product against a wall or in a corner. As with most furniture, do not place in direct sunlight or damp area—may cause discoloration and potential rust on metal surfaces. Not recommended for outdoor use.

PARTS

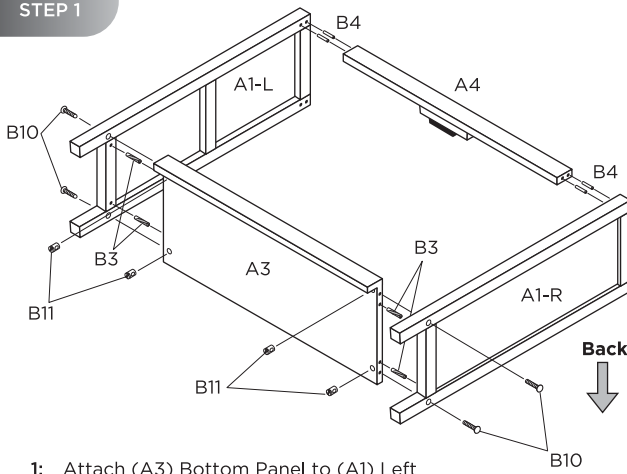


WARNING: Read and follow all warnings and instructions to avoid personal injury to pet or property damage.

READ BEFORE ASSEMBLY

- It is recommended that tank stand is assembled by two adults
- Save all packaging until assembly is completed
- Read ALL instructions
- Do not assemble on uneven flooring, including carpet
- Assemble on a clean non-marking surface
- Unpack all parts and hardware and check list to ensure nothing is missing

STEP 1

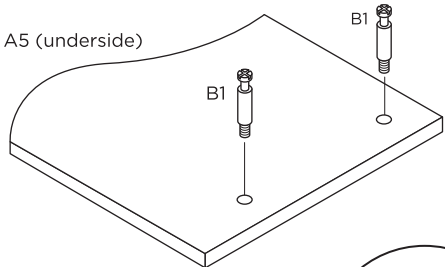


- 1: Attach (A3) Bottom Panel to (A1) Left Side Panel using (B10) Machine Screws, (B11) Nuts and (B3) Wood Dowels as shown.
- 2: Attach (A4) Front Bar to (A1) Left Side Panel using (B4) Small Wood Dowels.
- 3: Repeat Steps 1 & 2 with (A1) Right Side Panel.

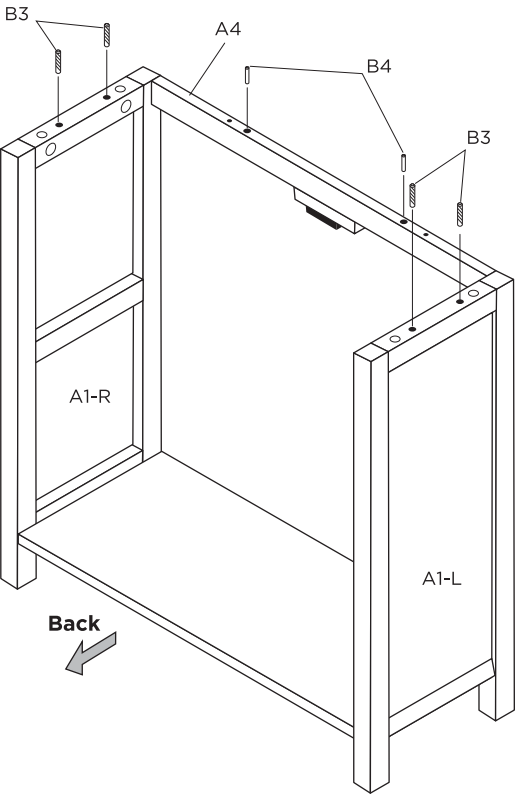
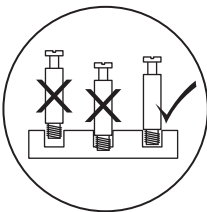
29-GALLON WOOD TANK STAND

STEP 2

- 1: Carefully position tank stand so that it is right-side up.
- 2: Insert (B1) Cam Lock Bolts into (A5) Top Panel.
- 3: Place (B3) Wood Dowels into (A1) Left & Right Side Panels and (B4) Small Wood Dowels into (A4) Front Bar.

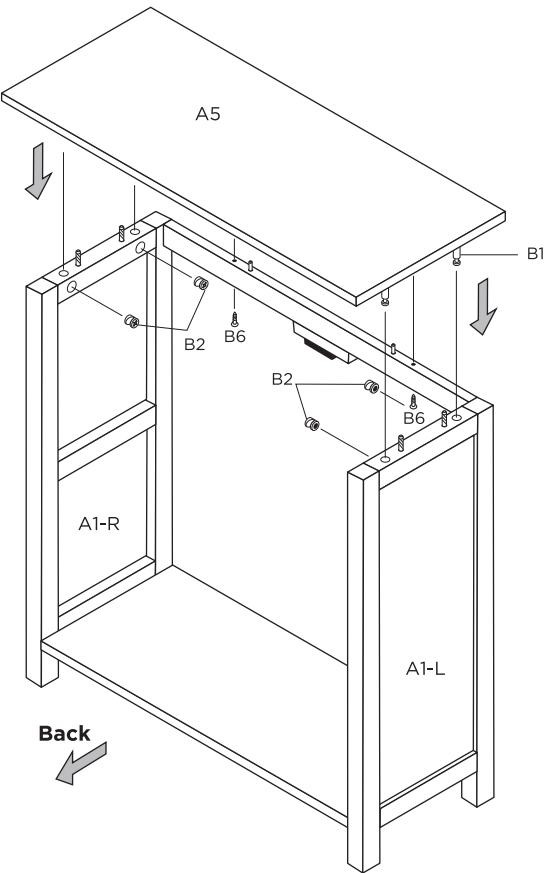


NOTE: Do not over tighten Cam Lock Bolts. Make sure each Cam Lock Bolt fits properly into the plastic threaded insert. Otherwise Cam Lock Nut may not be able to catch the head of the Cam Lock Bolt.

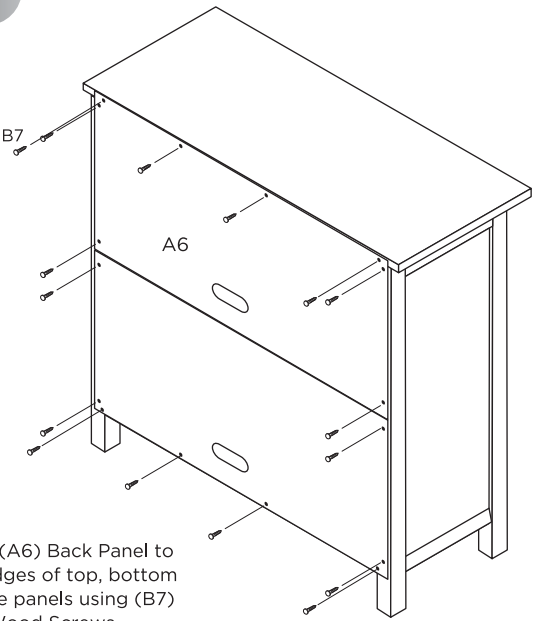


STEP 3

- 1: Set (A5) Top Panel on Side Panels and Front Bar.
- 2: Insert (B2) Cam Lock Nuts into (A1) Left & Right Side Panels.
- 3: Secure with (B2) Cam Lock Nuts and (B6) Wood Screws.

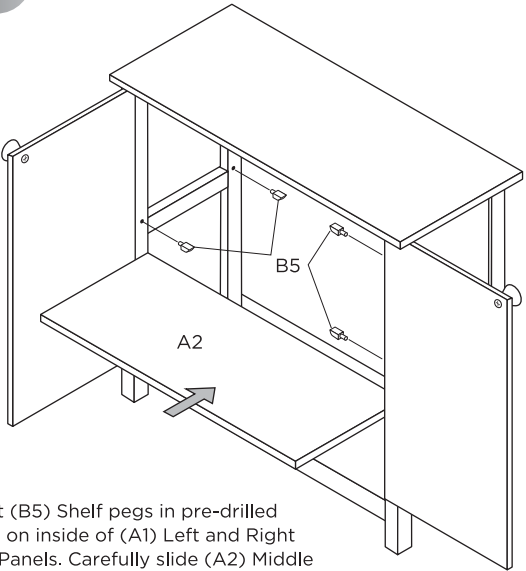


STEP 4



Attach (A6) Back Panel to back edges of top, bottom and side panels using (B7) Small Wood Screws.

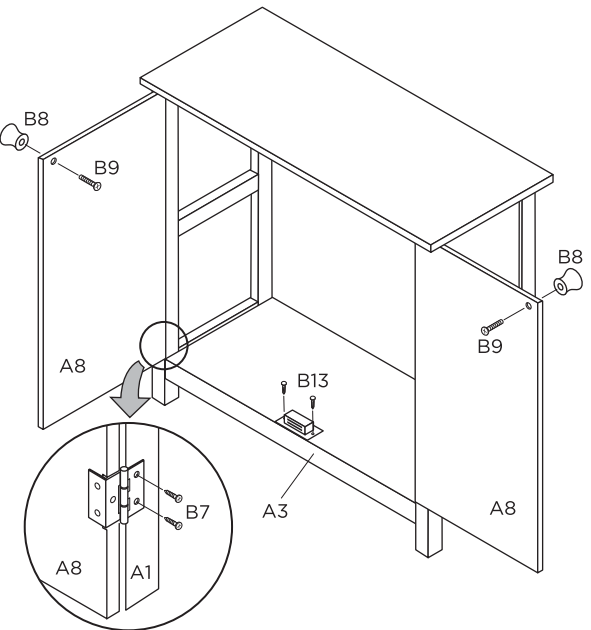
STEP 6



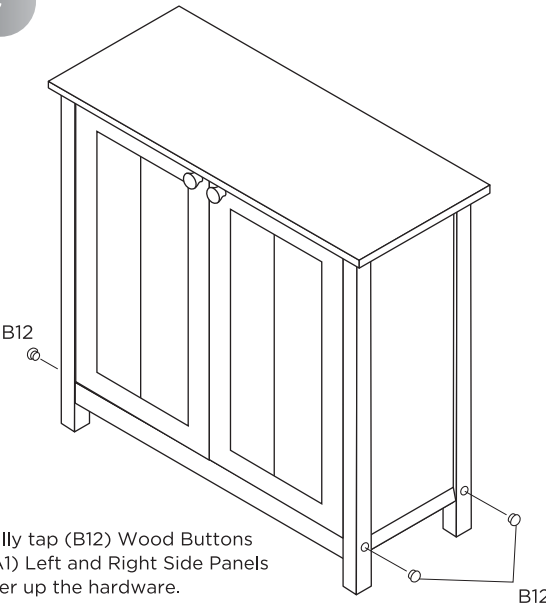
Insert (B5) Shelf pegs in pre-drilled holes on inside of (A1) Left and Right Side Panels. Carefully slide (A2) Middle Shelf into the stand so that it rests level on (B5) Shelf Pegs.

STEP 5

- 1: Attach (B8) Knobs to (A8) Doors using (B9) Machine Screws.
- 2: Attach (A8) Left and Right Doors to (A1) Left and Right Side Panels using (B7) Small Wood Screws.
- 3: Attach (B13) Magnet Hardware to (A3) Bottom Panel using the screws included in the set.



STEP 7



Carefully tap (B12) Wood Buttons into (A1) Left and Right Side Panels to cover up the hardware.
NOTE: Too much force can cause damage to the wood button or tank stand.
